WHAT IS TED

TED is an annual event where some of the world's leading thinkers and doers are invited to share what they are most passionate about. "TED" stands for Technology, Entertainment, Design - three broad subject areas that are, collectively, shaping our future. The program has since evolved to include ideas that matter in every discipline.

At a TED conference, the world's leading thinkers and doers are asked to give the talk of their lives in 18 minutes or less. Attendees have called it "the ultimate brain spa" and "a day-long journey into the future." The diverse audience of CEOs, scientists, creatives, philanthropists is almost as extraordinary as the speakers, who have included Elon Musk, Bill Clinton, Bill Gates, Jane Goodall, Sergey Brin, Paul Simon, Sir Richard Branson, Philippe Starck, Bono, Edward Snowden and many others.

TED was first held in Monterey, California, in 1984. In recent years, TED has expanded to include an international conference, TEDGlobal; In 2006 TED took the extraordinary step of making its talks available to the world, at no charge, over the internet.

TEDTalks began as a simple attempt to share what happens at TED with the world. Under the moniker "ideas worth spreading," talks were released online. They rapidly attracted a global audience in the millions. The reaction was so enthusiastic that the entire TED website has been reengineered around TEDTalks, with the goal of giving everyone on demand access to the world's most inspiring voices. 17 views per second, more than 1.5 million of views per day and more than 1 billion of total views are the clear sign of the success of the Ideas Worth Spreading program.

WHAT IS TEDx

In the spirit of ideas worth spreading, TEDx is a program of local, self-organized events that bring people together to share in a TED-like experience.

At TEDxLUISS and other TEDx events, TEDTalks video and live speakers combine to spark deep discussion and connection in a small group. These local, self-organized events

are branded TEDx, where x=independently organized TED event.

The TED conference provides general guidance for the TEDx program, but individual TEDx events are self-organized.

WHAT IS TEDxLUISS

Our event is called TEDxLUISS, where x = independently organized TED event. Our commitment is to create an event in which the participants are encouraged to communicate their passions in an exciting and engaging dialogue.

The theme of the second edition of TEDxLUISS is (r)evolution, a play on the words revolution and evolution.

(r)evolution

TEDxLUISS wants to bring together individuals who – with their revolutionary actions and ideas – bring about the radical change that is at the core of evolution.

At TEDxLUISS 2016 passionate and engaging speakers will share their personal revolution with the audience at LUISS Guido Carli and all around the world via live streaming.

The event will provide audience and speakers with a unique chance to share ambitions and projects of revolution and evolution of the world around us.




Massimo Moretti
